





Spatzle Soup for my Soul



So of course, the night before Bah Humbug, I just can't sleep. Maybe it's knowing that my butt has to get up before the sun, or maybe it's just my mind that can't seem to shut off. Either way, there I was lying in bed and the only thing my brain could think of was a series of books called "Chicken Soup for the Soul." Mind you, I've never read a book from the collection, but I have some summation of what it's about; an assortment of stories that basically warms the heart. Regardless, there was something about "Chicken Soup for the Soul," that made me think of Bah Humbug.
