

CARLO ACUTIS, a young Italian boy who is now up for Sainthood, was born on May 3, 1991. He was compassionate, kind, and devoted to Our Lady and the Eucharist. Carlo enjoyed playing video games and decided to use his talents on the computer to catalogue the Eucharistic Miracles of the

world! He researched over "136 Eucharistic Miracles" that occurred over the centuries in different countries throughout the world and have been acknowledged by the Church."

When Carlo was 11, he asked his parents to take him to all of the places the Eucharistic Miracles had occurred. Two and a half years later, the project was complete. He had created a website that hosted a virtual museum of these events. In addition, Carlo helped to create panel presentations that continue to travel around the world. Now Blessed. Carlo Acutis died one week after being diagnosed with Leukemia at the age of 15. More of his story can be found on the Carlo Acutis website. "The more Eucharist we receive, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of Heaven." Blessed Carlo Acutis.

# NEW TRANSLATION OF THE ORDER OF PENANCE \*You will see new Reconciling Individual Penitents by the Confessional.\*

Sacramental Considerations

"The sacrament of Penance is a whole consisting in three actions of the penitent and the priest's absolution. The penitent's acts are repentance, confession...and the intention to make reparation and do works of reparation" (Catechism of the Catholic Church [CCC], 1491). The Sacrament of Penance is both an act of Christ and an act of the Church. Christ accomplishes the work of reconciliation. He is the one who established the sacrament (see Mt 16:19 and Jn 20:19, 22-23); he is present in it; and he acts through it by bestowing the grace he merited for sinners through the saving work of his Paschal Mystery. The whole Church is involved in the ministry of reconciliation. The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated by the Church, it occurs in the context of the Church and, consequently, the effect of reconciliation is experienced through and by the whole Church. Accordingly, the Church acts as a priestly people whose members gather together, pray to God for his mercy, listen to the proclamation of the Word of God, examine their consciences, confess their sins, go to individual confession and receive absolution, praise God, and are sent forth.

### THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE

For something to be a sin it must meet all three criteria:

- 1) Serious matter
- 2) You have to know that the item is a sin.
- 3) You have to consciously will to do the sinful action (This would exclude dreams).

After Jesus declared that Peter would be the rock upon which he would build his Church, he said to Peter, "I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." (Mt 16:13-20)

### HOW?

### THE ORDER OF PENANCE

The Church celebrates the Sacrament of Penance using the Order of Penance.

The revised rites and formulas of the Order of Penance of the Second Vatican Council were promulgated in 1973. A new translation was provided in 2023. Celebrating the Sacrament of Penance or "going to confession" is a liturgical action that consists of:

- 1. The Reception of the Penitent
- 2. The Reading of the Word of God (Optional)
- 3. The Confession of Sins and The Acceptance of Satisfaction
- 4. The Prayer of the Penitent and The Absolution
- 5. The Proclamation of Praise of God and The Dismissal of the Penitent

### THE ACTS OF THE PENITENT

"Penance requires . . . the sinner to endure all things willingly,

be contrite of heart,

confess with the lips,

and practice complete humility and fruitful satisfaction." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1450)

- 1. Contrition (sorrow for sin)
- 2. Confession (inward examination, outward accusation)
- 3. Satisfaction (an act of penance)

### **GOING TO CONFESSION IN TWELVE EASY STEPS**

- 1. Examine your conscience, call to mind your sins, and then enter the confessional.
- 2. The priest will welcome and receive you.
- 3. Make the sign of the cross and say: "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."
- 4. The priest will invite you to trust in God. He may also read a text of Sacred Scripture.
- 5. Say these or similar words:
- "Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been \_\_\_\_long since my last confession. These are my sins..."
- 6. Tell the priest your sins. Then say these or similar words: "For these and all of my sins, I am sorry."
- 7. Accept your work of penance (prayers, act of kindness, etc.) to help make satisfaction and amend your life.
- 8. Express your sorrow for your sins (Act of Contrition) in these or similar words:
- "O my God, I am sorry and repent with all my heart for all the wrong I have done

and for the good I have failed to do,

because by sinning I have offended you,

who are all good and worthy to be loved above all things. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to do penance, to sin no more,

and to avoid the occasions of sin.

Through the merits of the Passion of our Savior Jesus Christ, Lord, have mercy."

- 9. Receive God's forgiveness as the priest prays the Prayer of Absolution.
- 10. At the end of the Prayer of Absolution, reply: "Amen."
- 11. Give praise to God. When the priest says: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good,"

conclude: "For his mercy endures forever."

12. Go in peace and remember to say or do your penance.

After his resurrection,
Jesus appeared to his disciples, extended his peace,
breathed the holy Spirit on them,
and sent them out saying,
"Whose sins you forgive
are forgiven them,
and whose sins you retain
are retained."

(Jn 20:19-23)
