Letter to be read to parishioners at all Masses August 26-27, 2023

TO: All Parishioners of Sacred Heart Parish and St. Mary Parish, both in St. Marys, PA

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

After collaborative consultations with Archabbot Martin Bartel, OSB, and the priests currently assigned to the three parishes in St. Marys, I have decided to establish Sacred Heart Parish and St. Mary Parish as partner parishes, according to the particular law of the Diocese of Erie. This means that they will share a pastor and parochial vicar, and collaborate closely with each other as much as possible. This status of partner parishes will be effective September 20, 2023.

Upon the presentation of Archabbot Martin, I have appointed the Reverend Thomas Curry, OSB, as pastor of both parishes and the Reverend Thomas More Sikora, OSB, as parochial vicar of both parishes. These appointments will also take effect on September 20, 2023.

Finally, in order to coordinate sacramental life, I have approved the following weekend Mass schedule for the two parishes:

Saturday Vigil Mass – 4:30 p.m. – St. Mary Church
 Sunday Masses
 7:00 a.m. – Sacred Heart Church
 9:00 a.m. – St. Mary Church
 10:30 a.m. – Sacred Heart Church

This new schedule will take effect on the weekend of September 23-24. Please note, the current Mass schedule at Queen of the World Parish will remain for the time being.

Allow me to offer some background to these decisions. Currently, the Diocese of Erie has 93 parishes – 40 of them are partnered with at least one other parish, and under the leadership of one pastor. This structure facilitates the close collaboration of the parish communities, parish staff and parish councils. While the finances of each

parish are separate, the parish finance councils frequently interact to maximize the impact of parish revenues and streamline expenses. Faith formation, liturgical planning, outreach and evangelization all benefit from a collaborative partnership. Ultimately, parishes working together reduces the burden on the priests, whose numbers are declining, both in the Diocese of Erie and St. Vincent Archabbey.

In St. Marys alone, we can see the need to make changes, just as they are happening across the diocese. While three parishes in St. Marys each have their own history and identity, I recognize the unique working relationship of St. Mary Parish and Sacred Heart Parish, both staffed by Benedictine priests. In October 2000, there were 8570 parishioners attending ten Sunday Masses at the three separate parishes in St. Marys, and these parishes were staffed by six priests. This past October, 1600 parishioners attended eight Sunday Masses staffed by four priests, including Fr. Eric Vogt who passed away in April. In addition to the significant drop in the number of Catholics who attend Mass in St. Marys each Sunday — again, similar to what we are seeing across northwest Pennsylvania — the Diocese of Erie and the Archabbey have far fewer priests with which to staff parishes.


Even though I know change is always challenging, we are fortunate to be able to keep all three parishes open for the time being, and to have three priests serving in the St. Marys area.

I would like to thank Archabbot Martin for his generosity, as well as Father Thomas Curry, Father Thomas More Sikora, and Father Jeffery Noble for ensuring that these changes are implemented effectively for your pastoral benefit. They are committed to continue working together so that the cooperation of the three parishes in many endeavors continues and even expands.

If our mission is to care for souls, celebrate the Eucharist, proclaim and live the Gospel, catechize the faithful and help others develop a personal relationship with Christ, we have no choice but to be open to change. I cannot emphasize strongly enough that although our structures may change, the mission Christ gave us to go forth and make disciples remains.

I look forward to working with you in a collaborative spirit, knowing we are doing what needs to be done to create parish communities that are vibrant, life-giving places of worship where people find encouragement and hope as they grow in their relationship with Christ, his Church and each other.
